SUBJECT: Changes in Submission Process of Emissions-Related Defect and Recall Reports under 40 CFR Part 1068, Subpart F

Dear Manufacturer:

The purpose of this letter is to advise manufacturers of changes in the submission process for emissions-related defect and recall reports, including investigation and quarterly reports, for manufacturers who are subject to the provisions of 40 CFR Part 1068, Subpart F.

Currently, manufacturers are submitting this information to EPA in many formats and via several distribution methods which creates an undue burden on the EPA and manufacturers to collect, maintain and report out on this information. As EPA continues to streamline all certification and compliance reporting processes, we are taking several steps to help address these issues.

First, EPA is making reporting templates available for your immediate use on our website at: <u>https://www3.epa.gov/otaq/verify/publications.htm#edir</u>.

Templates are now available for the following reports: Investigation and/or Emissions Defect Information Report Form, Remedial Plan Report Form, and Quarterly Report Form.

Second, effective immediately, EPA is now requiring that all defect, recall, and related reports be submitted to EPA via the Verify Document Module. Instructions for how to submit these reports can also be found on the website noted above.
