Subject: Webinar on Revisions to the Production Volume Reporting Module to Incorporate Additional Industries

Dear Manufacturer:

The purpose of this letter is to invite you to a webinar being hosted by the Environmental Protection Agency to provide information about revisions to the new EV-CIS Production Volume Reporting Module to incorporate additional industries. *Please note that this same information was sent via the EVCIS list server on August 11, 2021.* The new Production Volume Reporting Module is part of an ongoing effort to collect comprehensive compliance reporting data and streamline and standardize the data collection process. It is intended to help reduce burden on the regulated community and ensure data integrity through enhanced validation.

The following additional industries will be able to submit information for compliance with the production volume reporting requirements in time for submission of new model year 2021 reports:

- Specialty Vehicle Engines (Part 85)
- Electric Motorcycles (Part 86)
- Heavy-Duty Vehicle GHG Phase II (Part 1037)
- Marine Compression-Ignition Engines (Part 1042)
- Marine Spark-Ignition Engines (Part 1045)
- Large Spark-Ignition Engines (Part 1048)
- All-Terrain Vehicles, Off-Highway Motorcycles, Snowmobiles (Part 1051)
- Small Spark-Ignition Engines (Part 1054)

The remaining industries (Locomotives, Nonroad Compression Ignition Engines, and On-Highway Motorcycles) are planned to be incorporated into the module in time for submission of model year 2022 production volume reports.

During the webinar, we will discuss process changes, provide an overview of the planned revisions to the existing module, demonstrate the user interface and available features, provide tentative deployment plans, and allow time for questions and comments.

Two one-hour webinars will be hosted on **Wednesday, September 22, 2021**, from **10:00am to 11:00am** and **2:00pm to 3:00pm ET**. The content presented at each webinar will be the same. Information for connecting to the webinars is enclosed.
