Subject: Webinar on Revisions to the EV-CIS Production Volume Reporting Module to Incorporate Nonroad Compression-Ignition Engines (NRCI) Industry for Model Year 2022 and Later Reports

Dear Manufacturer:

The purpose of this letter is to invite you to a webinar being hosted by the Environmental Protection Agency to provide information about revisions to the new EV-CIS Production Volume Reporting Module to incorporate the nonroad compression-ignition engines (NRCI) industry. The new Production Volume Reporting Module is part of an ongoing effort to collect comprehensive compliance reporting data and to streamline and standardize the data collection process. It is intended to help reduce burden on the regulated community and ensure data integrity through enhanced integrated help and data validation.

By the end of this year, NRCI manufacturers will be able to submit model year 2022 production volume reports to the new Production Volume Reporting module as well as any needed updates to pre-model year 2022 reports. The exact date of the production release will not be known by the webinar date but will be announced as soon as it is determined.

During the webinar, we will discuss changes to the production volume reporting process, provide an overview of the planned revisions to the module, provide details about the production volume data import feature, demonstrate the features of the user interface, and allow time for questions and comments.

Two one-hour webinars will be hosted on **Wednesday, April 13, 2022**, from **10:00am to 11:00am ET** and **2:00pm to 3:00pm ET**. The content presented at each webinar will be the same. Information for connecting to the webinars is enclosed.
