**SUBJECT: Deployment of Production Volume Reporting Module Updates for Heavy-duty Vehicles**

Dear Manufacturer:

The purpose of this letter is to announce the deployment date of updates to address the resource limitations that have prevented heavy-duty vehicle manufacturers from submitting large model year 2021 production volume reports. (For more information on this issue, see [CD-2022-06](#), issued on May 9, 2022.

The updates are scheduled to be deployed on Friday, July 22, 2022 (with a planned back-up date of July 29, 2022). This means that beginning Monday, July 25, 2022 (or August 1, 2022, if the back-up date is needed), heavy-duty vehicle manufacturers will be able to use the Production Volume Reporting module to submit large model year 2021 and later production volume reports.
